



Health and Social Care



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Courses available:

Level 1 Health and Social Care - This course provides pathways into the sector of health and social care and early years. Subject teachers have industry experience which is shared with learners. This provides a stimulating learning environment and promotes positive learning. This course will also help develop those all-important employability skills that will help you decide on your career path. Alongside the course, you will also attend visits and trips to support and enhance your classroom delivery.

Level 2 Certificate in Health and Social Care - This is a full time study programme which covers a range of health and social care topics. The units are assessed internally by subject teachers. Over the 1 year duration of this course, you will cover a variety of topics that link to health and social care which will allow you to explore the health and social care sector in more detail and the career opportunities available.

Level 3 Technical Extended Certificate in Health and Social Care - This is a full time, 2-year study programme, which covers a range of health and social care topics, which are assessed internally and externally. Learners will prepare for a health-related career with this Health and Social Care course, equivalent to A Levels. It will give you the opportunity to develop your academic and writing skills and apply your knowledge to a real-life setting during practical work experience.



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Level 3 Health and Social Care: Cadet Programme

Tameside College are working in partnership Tameside & Glossop Integrated Care NHS Foundation Trust (T&G ICFT) and Tameside Council (TMBC), Tameside and Glossop CCG (T&G CCG) and Pennine Care NHS Foundation Trust (PCT), to offer you a bespoke level 3 course in Health and Social Care. Forming part of this course you will be exposed to a range of work experience across the health and social care sector.

Placement opportunities across health and social care will include district nursing, radiology, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech and language therapy, laboratories, hospital wards, social care, learning disabilities, community response and GP surgeries.

As the programme encourages an in-depth understanding of “neighbourhood working” and how services are provided across systems opportunities to gain insight into charities, independent and voluntary organisations within Tameside and Glossop will be also provided.



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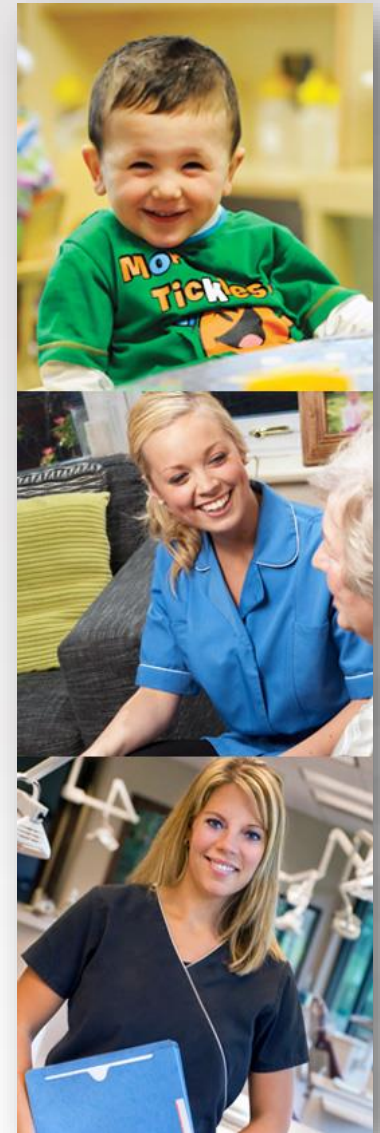


Learning experience:

- Level 2 Certificate in Early years

On successful completion of the Level 2, you can progress onto:

- Level 3 in Health and Social Care (Advanced)
- Apprenticeship
- Employment with the health and social care sector

On successful completion of a 2-year Level 3 qualification, you can progress onto:

- University/ Higher Education
- Full time employment in the health and social care sector such as Adult Residential Care Home, Day Centre, Children's Centre or Health Centre.
- Advanced Apprenticeship
