

3.0 THE PROPOSED SCHEME

3.1 OVERVIEW

The scheme proposes refurbishment of the Victoria Building C Floor to accommodate the required spaces for the T-Level health & science requirements.

The re-use of the space provides a highly efficient and cost effective repurposing of 722m² of tired Condition C accommodation as follows

- 4no. general teaching class spaces
- 3no. IT suites
- 1 no. large skills ward
- circulation and support space

The Skills Ward is the centerpiece of the works and will provide a range of realistic working environments for the students.

To the left of the Ward entrance, the suite provides several bed spaces with hoists, clinical chairs and cots all overseen by a reception desk and waiting area to replicate a surgery and pharmacy situation.

To the right of the ward entrance, the suite provides a living areas to simulate working in a care at home situation from working with baths and wcs to working in living and dining areas.

Both practical suites are supported by an adjacent write up and group work space for students without them needing to leave the practical space.
